- We need to plan B, in case something like the Burger van doesn't turn up. We were fortunate Facebook saved the day.
- Need to contact HBC continually to collect the grass, not just cut it.
- We need to make sure that people do what they said they would do eg. Y-Services offered 4 activities and only did 2.
- With regard to the attack of the young man (14yrs), perhaps we should have phoned the ambulance earlier. Having said that he didn't have an adult with him which is why we were hesitant to call an ambulance. The paramedics did comment that our First Aiders did a great job and acted appropriately, if we hadn't the outcome could have been different.
- We need to keep enough water in the First Aid tent both for poorly residents and for volunteers.
- The First Aid supplies need to be suitable, we didn't have enough thick gauze, cold compresses and not enough water available.

Next year
